

Where can I store my data?

NETWORK DRIVES

While convenient, the local hard-drive on your computer, drive C:, is not the preferred place to store your files. In case your hard drive fails or gets damaged (dropped laptop, spilled coffee, and so on), your important files and information stored on the C: drive are irretrievably lost.

When you save files to your H: drive, the files are saved to a network drive - it's securely backed up, and accessible from anywhere: even from computers off-site (when using the VPN connection). You may have other network drives: for your department's files,
